


**MINUTES OF STREETS AND ROADS COMMITTEE MEETING
FOR TOWN OF STAR VALLEY**

- **CONSENT AGENDA ITEMS:**

1. **Approval of the minutes from the Streets and Roads Commission meeting held on November 12, 2009.**

 **Motion: Action: Approve the minutes, Moved by Chairperson Richard Pinkerton , Seconded by Member Mark Freegard.**

- **DISCUSSION AND POSSIBLE ACTION ITEMS:**

1. **Discussion and update regarding storm damage to bridge crossing on Rainbow and Houston Drive.**

Chairperson Pinkerton stated that the stream bed near Houston trailer park sustained damage and needs repairs. Building Official Joe Janusz stated that several contractors are reviewing backwashed apron issues in the stream bed, however, the debris is an issue. Mr. Janusz further stated that the Star Valley street crew will need to clean the area out before a contractor can review the issues. Mr. Janusz stated he would guess the damage repair to cost around three thousand dollars to the Town (3,000.00). Commission Member Stephenson stated he had not seen the stream beds run so quickly with such a capacity of water as they did during the heavy rain storm. Chairperson Pinkerton agreed and stated that erosion on Mayfield Canyon rd is also an issue. Mr. Janusz stated 4” of undercut and rocks could help to fix the issues. The street crew men could fix the problem without the need of contractors.

2. **Discussion and update regarding storm damage to Star Valley streets and roads.**

Chairperson Pinkerton stated this item was discussed in agenda item one.

3. **Discussion and possible action regarding the placement of 15mph signs and ‘Children at Play’ signs on Orion Dr.**

Chairperson Pinkerton stated that north of the Star Valley Baptist Church the side roads have extremely fast drivers and the Commission has had several requests for safety signs. Chairperson Pinkerton further stated that any 15mph road signs would have to be approved by the Sheriff's department before the Town could proceed. Vice-Chairperson Vincent asked if the signs would work to slow down traffic based on past experiences. Chairperson Pinkerton stated he felt they had helped in the past to slow traffic down. Mr. Janusz stated the Town does have street signs at Town Hall if and when the Commission is ready to put them in.

 **Motion: Action: Approve the consent agenda items, Moved by Member Larry Stephenson, Seconded by Member Mark Freegard.**


4. Discussion and possible action regarding parking control on Moonlight Dr. with parallel or no parking options.

Chairperson Pinkerton stated that in the past diagonal parking along the side of the 'Lumberman's' building on Moonlight Dr just before 260 hwy has always caused a safety issue. Chairperson Pinkerton suggested either 'No Parking' signs or parallel parking be enforced in this area. Chairperson Pinkerton further added that this is a safety issue for the Town as it is in the Town's right of way. Vice-Chairperson Vincent suggested waiting on any action until the building is bought or some other change is made. Commission Member Stephenson suggested placing 'No Truck Parking' signs to reduce the size of vehicles using the space. Commission Member Freegard also suggested waiting if there are no zoning issues.

 **Motion: Action: To delay on the agenda item for the building to be rented or bought before changing in parking is discussed. Moved by Member Larry Stephenson, Seconded by Member Mark Freegard.**

5. Discussion and possible action regarding repairs of flood damage on Mayfield Canyon Rd.

Mr. Janusz stated he had discussed the issue with the Town street crew on how to control erosion inside the curve off of Skyrun Dr. The street crew felt the Town needs to compact the area with rock and gunite the surface five foot width from ditch. Mr. Janusz also stated that the APS box at bottom of the curve would need to be reinforced to keep erosion from obstructing it as well. Chairperson Pinkerton stated he believed 725' of materials would be needed to complete the job. Chairperson Pinkerton stated he did feel that something needed to be done before another storm hits

6. Discussion and possible action regarding hot mix repairs for Moonlight Dr. (south of Starlight Drive) and Rainbow Dr (inside of curves by trailer park).

Chairperson Pinkerton stated that the inside of the curve keeps getting hit and cold patch will not hold. Chairperson Pinkerton stated that a 145' along the

curve with hot mix would be required. Further more the mail boxes have cold patches which are getting torn up. This will require 3500' total for both areas hot mix. Commission Member Freegard asked who would be doing the work. Mr. Janusz stated the Town street crew can do the work

7. Discussion and presentation by Bill Heath regarding the possible dedication of Latigo Ln. to the Town of Star Valley.

Mr. Heath presented to the Commission his request for dedication of Latigo Lane, a private road, to the Town of Star Valley for maintenance and upgrades.

Mr. Heath displayed a road map of the area for the Commission to view.

Discussion of neighbors and right of ways along with possible improvements as well as possible Town liability issues were all discussed by the Commission Members.
